

# LLSC Tuesday Night League 2025

The LLSC Board has voted and passed the following rules for Tuesday Night League-2025. For those that shoot in both Tuesday and Thursday night leagues, please don't be confused with the rules of BVI Thursday Night League. BVI is not overseen by the LLSC Board of Directors and is independent of the Club.

Team fees will remain at \$70.00. This covers the administrative costs. Administrative costs include worker(s) collecting and disbursing money, creating schedules, recording keeping etc. The individual weekly fee is \$21.00 per Shooter. \$3.00 of the \$21.00 is prize money.

Each team must have a minimum of 5 shooters per week. The Prize money of \$3.00 must be paid for those who are not in attendance that week. In return a "Ghost" score will be provided of 15 for singles, 15 for Handicap.

At the beginning of the season, all teams will be included in one division. This helps with scheduling team and trap variety. Our new club manager is working to recruit younger members to be involved in the club, and we will not attempt to determine what division to place a team in without prior performance. Actual team performance will be used to divide the teams into two divisions at the end of the season. Teams will be sharing the trap each evening but will not be competing against each other for team points. Many teams have enjoyed sharing a trap with a better performing team to learn from them and enhance their skills.

## Scoring will be as follows:

Weekly team scores will only include the top 5 shooters from 16's and Handicap. In the event there are not five shooters the paid ghost score will be included.

The individual scores will be recorded whether or not they are included in the overall team scores. Individual averages will be displayed on the score sheet.

## Prizes will be awarded as follows:

Team awards - Raw Scores of 16's and Handicaps will be combined for determining the tiers.

And example: If there are 10 teams, the top five teams will be placed in the top bracket (tier) and awarded 1, 2 and 3<sup>rd</sup>. The remaining teams will be placed in the second bracket (tier) and awarded 1, 2 and 3<sup>rd</sup>. In case of an odd number of teams the 2<sup>nd</sup> tier will be the larger group.

## Individual prize money will be divided as follows.

Those who participate less than 7 times will not be considered for prize money. The top 7 scores for Singles and Handicap will be combined and ranked to determine The Top Gun prize and will also create two brackets (Tiers) for individual awards. There will be 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place for 16's and for Handicap. In the case of tie, we will look at the 10 week overall percentage and choose the higher number. If there is still a tie, the prize money will be split.

Individuals are only eligible for one prize. (i.e. the Top Gun winner cannot also win top handicap or top 16's) The order for awards will be OA, Handicap 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> then 16's 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>.

We want to ensure everyone tries to participate only on Tuesday Night's. However, we understand there can be extenuating circumstances. If you need to do makeup, you have until Sunday of that same week to complete it. Make-ups must be scheduled with Andrew Bain, the LLSC Club Manager. If the club cancels a shoot due to inclement weather (lightening within 5 miles), the season will be extended by one week. We will no longer allow more than three make-ups per 10-week season.
